

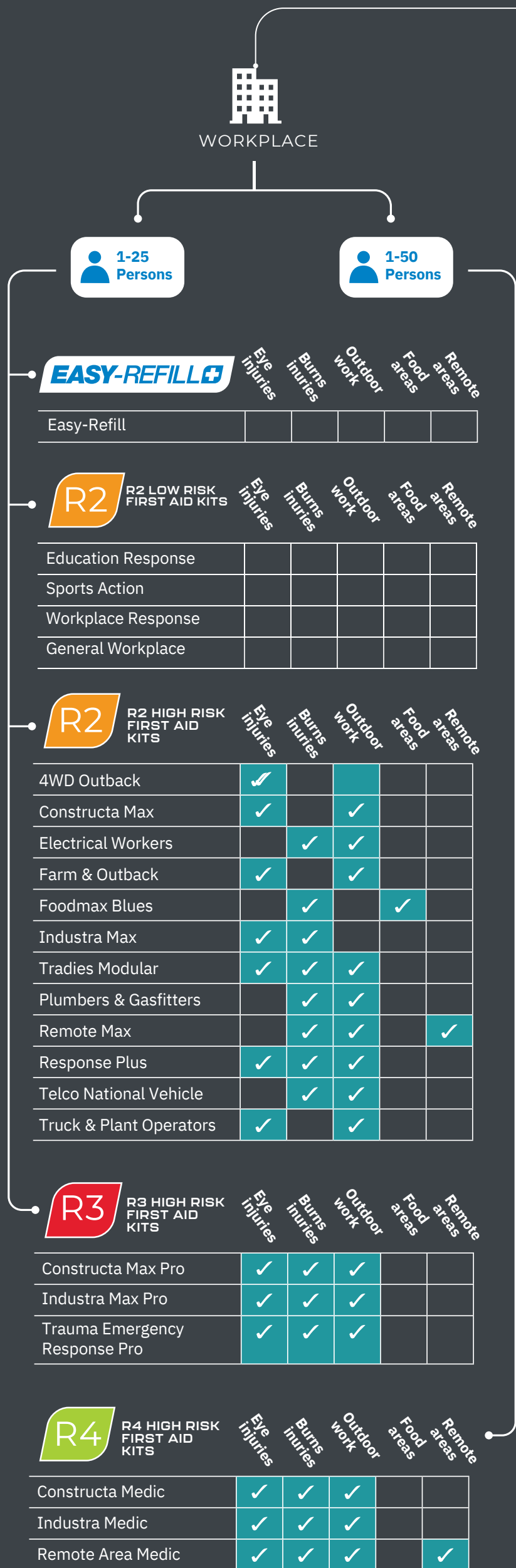
Your Guide to First aid compliance

A simple guide to discover what you need to ensure first aid compliance

- ➔ **What is a low risk worksite?** A workplace where workers are not exposed to hazards that could result in serious injury or illness. Examples; School's, Library, Offices
- ➔ **What is a high risk worksite?** A workplace where workers are exposed to hazards that could result in serious injury or illness. Examples; Construction sites, tradies, manufacturing plants, mine sites

Other key considerations to ensure you are first aid ready

- Low risk - one qualified first aider for every 50 workers
- High risk - one qualified first aider for every 25 workers
- Remote - one qualified first aider for every 10 workers
- Well recognised first aid signage
- Eye wash and showers for chemicals or major burns
